OPPORTUNITIES

- Build robust Al products that citizens can rely on.
- Respect intellectual property and promote ethics in Al.

MAIN POINTS

• As healthcare providers dealing with health data, online pharmacies fall in a high-risk category.

Risk-based approach.

UNACCEPTABLE RISK

Highest level of risk prohibited in the EU. Includes AI systems using e.g. subliminal manipulation or general social scoring.

HIGH RISK

Most regulated Al systems, as these have the potential to cause significant harm if they fail or are misused, e.g. if used in law enforcement or recruiting.

LIMITED RISK

Includes AI systems with a risk of manipulation or deceit, e.g. chatbots or emotion recognition systems, Humans must be informed about their interaction with the AI.

MINIMAL RISK

All other Al systems, e.g. a spam filter, which can be deployed without additional restrictions.

PENALTIES

- Fines of up to €20M or at least 6% of the total annual worldwide turnover.
 - » Existing liability, data protection, and copyright law to be respected
 - » Additional diligence may be required as early as 2025
